
ORDER REGARDING MOTION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR CLARIFICATION

At a session of said Court held,
Detroit, Wayne, Michigan, on
October 10, 2017.

Plaintiff having filed a 10/6/17 motion for reconsideration or clarification;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Court's October 4, 2017 order is clarified as follows: Having prevailed in its action under the Freedom of Information Act, Plaintiff is entitled to reasonable attorneys' fees, costs, and disbursements under MCL 15.240(6), as well as punitive damages in the amount of \$1,000 pursuant to MCL 15.240(7). Plaintiff is directed to submit a bill of costs within 21 days of receipt of the subject recording. Any objections must be filed within 14 days of service of said bill of costs. The parties will be notified if oral argument is necessary.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the civil fine provided for in MCL 15.240(7) will not be imposed because the Court determined that Defendant's denial of Plaintiff's request for records was not undertaken arbitrarily, capriciously, willfully, intentionally, or in bad faith.
